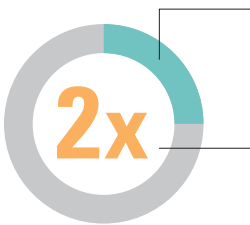

The only program of its kind in the region, The Women's Cancer Center is integrated throughout our 13 locations to provide a collaborative and cohesive approach to specialized care for women at high risk for cancer, newly diagnosed with cancer and surviving cancer.



We are **1 of 70 National Cancer Institute-designated cancer centers** nationwide. Receiving a second opinion at an NCI-designated cancer center benefits patients, and in one study changed the diagnosis for 43% of breast cancer patients.



Patients who receive care at NCI-designated centers have a **25% greater** chance of survival over other centers.

Our breast radiologists **find early stage breast cancer** at a rate **double the national standard**.

Ovarian cancer patients **receive the latest guideline-recommended care from a team of fellowship-trained gynecologic oncologists**. Nationwide, more than 60% of ovarian cancer patients do not receive this level of care because they are not treated by a gynecologic oncologist.



Our **multidisciplinary team** of specialists collaborates to develop a coordinated and **personalized care plan unique to each patient**.

Our physicians are **subspecialty trained in women's cancers** and focus solely on the treatment and care of breast and gynecologic oncology patients. This level of experience and expertise results in **better outcomes, fewer complications and improved quality of life**.



Because there is an association among women's cancers, and in some cancers men develop, our **genetic counselors** can provide genetic testing and help you and your family understand your risk.
